

The project aims to accelerate the transition of **SMEs** in the **agrifood** industry towards a **sustainable growth model** by increasing uptake of recommended measures from **energy audits**.

A surrounding ecosystem is built to achieve this goal, including a **capacity-building training** programme, tailored measures and collective **pilot activities** including energy communities, common purchasing, & a roadmap for the deployment of renewable energy sources.

Expected achievements

- 80 energy audits carried out
- 600 company staff with improved knowledge and skills
- 1 out of 2 recommended measures from audits translated into concrete implementation
- 100+ companies benefiting from direct support

Ongoing progress

- 80 agri-food companies audited, with 66,55 GWh/yr of potential energy savings identified and 7.26 M€ of potential cost savings
- A successful skills “acceleration programme”, with over 4.200 participants, and over 5.600 replay views for online sessions
- 20 companies receiving individual support for the implementation of measures recommended during audits
- Ongoing deployment of local pilots across all four project countries
