



The Industrial Energy Community of San Adrián (CEISA) Is Established After One Year of Collaborative Work Within the European AENEAM Project

April 27, 2026

On January 29, 2026, the Industrial Energy Community of San Adrián (CEISA) was officially established, concluding more than a year of joint efforts among companies, local entities, and energy-sector stakeholders.

The initiative has been developed within the framework of the European AENEAM Project, led by the Navarre Association of Industry (AIN) with the participation of NASUVINSA, aiming to promote energy efficiency and foster business cooperation within the industrial sector of the municipality.

This milestone marks the culmination of more than a year of information sessions, briefing, technical meetings, and specialized workshops focused on improving energy efficiency and exploring collaboration opportunities among companies in the industrial area of San Adrián.

A Participatory Process to Drive the Industrial Energy Transition

The process to create CEISA began on November 14, 2024, in the Plenary Hall of the San Adrián Town Hall, during a meeting chaired by the Councillor for Industry and Tourism, Eva Muro Viedma, with the participation of nine entities and companies interested in exploring the creation of an energy community in the municipality.

During the session, the activities of the AENEAM Project were presented. The project was approved under the Programme for Environment and Climate Action (LIFE) – LIFE-2022-CET call and aims to promote energy efficiency in the agri-food sector through audits, technical assistance, and a personalized capacity-building programme.

This initial meeting also received institutional support from the San Adrián Town Hall, the Association of Agri-Food Industries of Navarre, La Rioja and Aragón

(ALINAR), the National Centre for Food Technology and Safety (CNTA), and the Energy Transition Service of the Government of Navarre.

Nine Technical Sessions and an Energy Study

Throughout 2024 and 2025, nine in-person sessions were held, along with various online activities, including a programme for the promotion of Energy Communities offered by NASUVINSA through the Navarre Community Transformation Office (OTC Navarra).

This programme, consisting of four specialized sessions, took place between November 28 and December 16, 2025, at the San Adrián Coworking Space.

The sessions addressed, among other topics:

- Key concepts of industrial energy communities
- Legal framework and permitted activities
- Opportunities for the industrial environment
- Presentation of a real-life experience in an industrial estate
- Identification of energy synergies and cooperation pathways


In addition, AIN prepared a detailed study of the real energy consumption of the participating companies, enabling the identification of potential joint projects and laying the foundations for defining the scope of the new energy community.


Two Projects Submitted to the Navarre Government Grant Call

As a result of the technical work and commitment of the participating entities, on February 19, 2026, CEISA submitted funding applications for several projects under the 2026 Energy Communities Grant Call of the Government of Navarre, through the Department of Industry and Ecological and Digital Business Transition / Energy Transition Service.
